On Wednesday, 23 May, together with Australian National University (ANU), Stargazing Live is calling on all Australians to help smash the Guinness World Records title for the most people in one country stargazing at the same time, asking over 30, 000 people across multiple sites to simultaneously observe an object in the night sky through a telescope for the same 10-minute period.

Remember to look up at the stars and not down at your feet. Try to make sense of what you see and wonder about what makes the universe exist. Be curious. And however difficult life may seem, there is always something you can do and succeed at. It matters that you don't just give up.






