
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Library News

Year 2 have been listening and reading a variety of Fairy Tales this term and part of their learning required them to use their designing skills in pairs or by themselves. You may have heard about **STEM** which are activities designed for children to use science, technology, engineering and mathematical concepts to develop a solution to a problem. At school we also like to include the Artistic and creative side of design.

Year 2 have developed their design skills using several **STEM** activities for Rapunzel and Goldilocks and the 3 Bears. The children had to design a safe escape route for Rapunzel from the tower. Many chose a slide for a safe escape. They had to measure the height of the escape route and evaluate its safety aspects. Would Rapunzel require safety equipment such as a helmet, arm and knee pads? Several children had to re-evaluate their design as it wasn't that safe.

In the second activity, the children had to create a bed for Goldilocks to sleep in. Goldilocks was weighted down with washers and once again measurements were checked and recorded. Once this was deemed safe for Goldilocks, the bed was also tested to see if it would hold the members of the Bear Family. Each one was heavier or lighter than Goldilocks. All students got to test their creations and I can happily report that their new bed was "Just right" for Goldilocks.


