So what does a class parent do?

Be Sociable: Be approachable, friendly and welcoming – especially if there are new families joining your class in 2019. Promote school social events and help coordinate the refreshments at your class' family mass.

Be a Communicator: Send regular communication to your year group about what's going on at school. Make sure your parent group are aware of the communication tools already available at the school - School Website, School App, QKR app for payments, Weekly Newsletter and Parents Facebook group run by the P&F.

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Be Supportive: Offer support to families in need – this can be as simple as listening. It is not part of the role to take on board parent feedback / complaints; just be a referral point to direct them to the appropriate channels – classroom teacher, school principal, family liaison officer.

Be Involved: Maintain contact with other class parents for support and guidance. And encourage involvement of your parent group in school activities.

Week 6 was a busy one for OOSH! We got into the Christmas spirit with some festive craft and decorated the room with the artwork from it. The children made Christmas trees using a template which they folded together themselves and then decorated. They also made wooden ornaments which they proudly displayed on the Christmas tree they put up themselves. It looks fantastic and the bright tinsel and Santa, sitting atop the tree, really brighten up the room.

Aside from the Christmas activities, we had loom band jewelry as a really popular activity, a geography quiz spurred on by our inquisitive children and the fairy gardens got a workout with the children setting up areas to play and hang out in. We also had games of touch football, cricket, 44 homes and jail, a basketball game.

This week, we have continued to make Christmas a main theme, but we have also focused on learning and performing, based off our observations of the kids recently. We had children engaged in some games on their tablets, utilising technology as a learning resource, a science experiment at before school care and a look at some craft activities for Albania's and Barbados' national days, on Wednesday and Friday, respectively. Some other highlights included an OOSH talent show, yoga, and gardening and capture the flag. In the kitchen, we made sure to include a chocolate cake for 'world cake day' on Monday.
