We also discussed the importance of minimizing our impact on the environment as much as possible and what we can reduce, reuse and recycle, with some colouring in and answer sheets.

Other experiences included 'Athena' puppets for Greek Independence Day, dioramas and photoshop cartoons, where we used photos of the kids and applied effects to them to create our own OOSH cartoon strip. Popular sports throughout the week included soccer tournaments, basketball, tennis and cricket.

Magic shows and paper plane contests completed our jam-packed week, which saw us reach a new record for attendance at after school care, with 41 kids on Wednesday!

This week we have started on our Easter craft! With lots of exciting arts crafts such as Easter bunnies, foam Easter kits, stickers and much more, the kids had lots of fun creating! We made Vietnamese rice paper rolls on Monday, a nice way to try different foods and have emphasis on healthy eating.

The children also made their own lava lamps, using Alka-Seltzer tablets, food colouring, water and vegetable oil. Acrostic poems for Senegal's new year and gymnastics were just a few of the other highlights on our program for week 10.

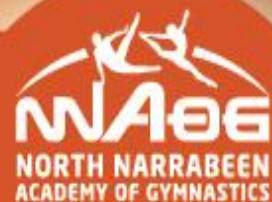

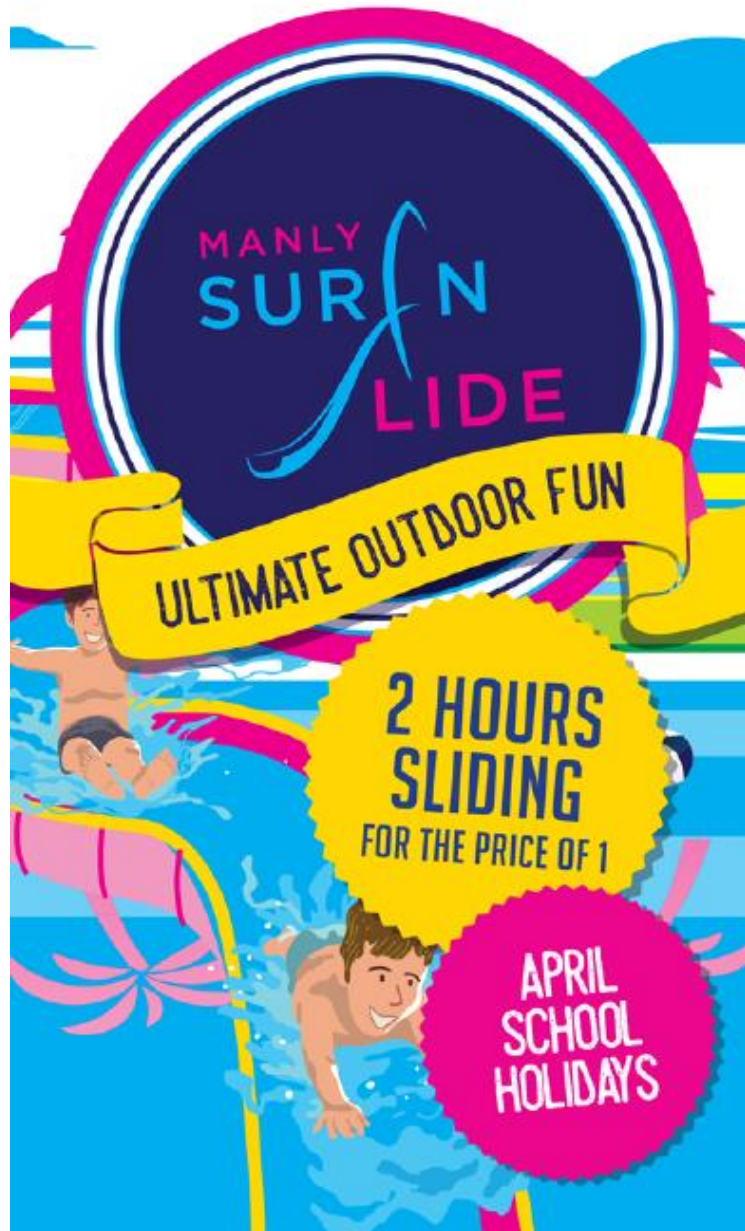


