Weeks 3 and 4 News

For week 3, we had lot of fun activities and experiences spread across both before and after school care. Starting the week with science, we tried the 'walking water experiment.' We set out 7 cups, the kids filled every second one up with water and put red in the first cup, yellow in the third, blue in the fifth and red in the seventh. They then put paper towel in each cup to form a bridge. We asked the kids what they predicted would happen and they were spot on with their responses. When we returned half an hour later, the water had 'walked' from cup to cup, turning the empty cups into orange, green and purple cups of water.

A requested activity has been to do some painting, so we thought we'd combine that with international peace day. The brief was to make a collaborative poster, with whatever peace means to them. We know how great they are when it comes to art and craft, but we (and every parent who got to see it) were blown away by how well they nailed it! We asked the kids if they wanted to water the garden, with the mint starting to grow back. We loved he enthusiasm, they jumped at the chance to help out. We said that we'll need to plant new herbs and vegetables after the others died at the end of last term. When asked what herbs and veg they wanted to grow, basil, strawberries and tomatoes were the most popular.
