Dear Parents,

St Kevin's Catholic Primary School Dee Why – 2020 School Fees

I wish to advise that in 2020, both tuition and school resource fees will rise by 1.5%. There will be no increase in the Diocesan Building Levy.

This increase has been endorsed by the Diocesan Schools Finance Committee and the Bishop's Office and is at the low end of the possible range of increase that was communicated to parents in 2018.

In 2020 the fee structure for the first child in our school will be:

	K-6
Tuition Fee	\$ 1,631.00
School Resource Fee *	\$ 796.00
Building Levy	\$ 970.00
TOTAL	\$ 3,397.00

*May exclude camps, electives or other student specific fees that your school may charge

I can confirm that sibling discounts on tuition fees will continue to apply as in previous years. These discounts provide a 20% reduction for the second child, 50% for the third child and 100% for fourth and subsequent children.

Statements are sent out each month to show payments made or items billed in the preceding month. Fees can be paid in instalments – weekly, fortnightly, monthly or annually.

To make payment of the fees easier there are several ways of paying:

- The easiest method for both you and the school is to establish a regular BPay transfer- details at the top of your Tax Invoice and statements.
- > You can also pay via Qkr! refer to the school website for instructions on how to download the app
- We also accept EFTPOS /Credit Card at the school office or by filling in the slip at the bottom of your statement.

Families are reminded that those struggling to pay school fees or with any financial concerns should contact the Fee Liaison Unit at the Catholic Schools Office <u>schoolfees@dbb.org.au</u> or myself. No family desiring a Catholic Education will be excluded due to hardship.

I thank all our families for their ongoing commitment to our school and acknowledge and appreciate the sacrifices they make in order to ensure their children receive a Catholic Education.
