Families will be given the opportunity to browse through some of the latest titles, posters, book packs and a variety of stationery items in our MINI BOOK SHOP, set up in the Library. These fabulous Scholastic items can be purchased and taken home. A percentage of the Book Fair proceeds goes right back to our school in the form of book commission.

Students will be given the opportunity to browse through the books on offer during their library time on the Friday. Students in Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2 are encouraged to bring along their mums or dads to help them choose appropriate books/ items and assist with their purchases. Book Club Orders (#1) have been delivered. Purchases have been distributed this week. Thank you for your purchases.

READ WITH ME CLUB

The Read With Me Club is a reading scheme that encourages parents and children to share reading together for **10 minutes or more every night**.

Students can read as many books as they like several times a day. The record card is completed each day. Simply date and sign (just once per day). There is no need to record the name of the book.

When the first record sheet is completed it is returned to the class teacher. Your child will then receive their first certificate for reading 25 times. A new record sheet will then be attached. Children will receive a certificate for every 25 times they have read. **Upon reaching 100, students will receive a book that is theirs to keep forever. This book will be presented at the FRIDAY ASSEMBLY.**

If your child reads every night from the start of the program they should receive their first book during term 2. They can receive up to 3 books a year!

Children are encouraged to read quality literature that has been borrowed from school or the public library. Reading should be an enjoyable activity for all. Parents should be reading to their child from Kindergarten – Year 2. Discuss what is happening in the story, by looking at the pictures in detail. Encourage your child to read aloud where there is rhythm and rhyme. Older students will read silently, but reading aloud can help them develop expression, fluency, and rhythm.
