Responsible decision-making

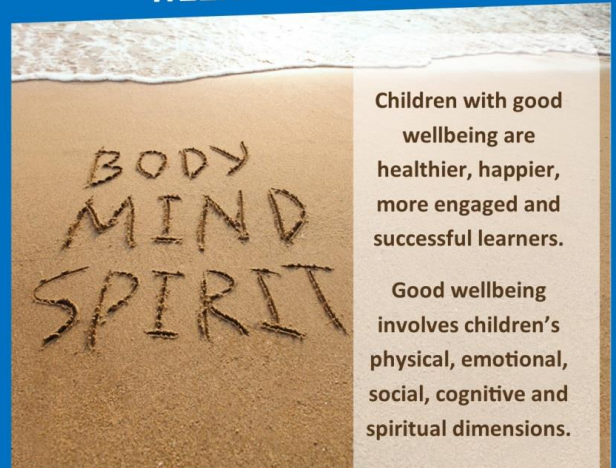
Choosing wisely and thoughtfully.

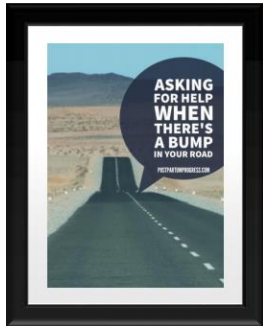
