

LunchFox app to order healthy lunches from local cafes.

Lunches are delivered directly in one bulk order to the school.

Orders must be placed by midnight the night before.

School Lunch Orders

At St Kevin's, we use a service called LunchFox: an app that allows parents to order healthy school lunches from local cafes.

Menus follow Nutrition Australia guidelines and we have partnered with some amazing cafes across five days a week. All orders are delivered straight to school, in time for lunch.

- A medical form will need to be completed if your child requires any medication at school. This includes Panadol, Nurofen, Antibiotics etc.
- **Sick bay** is beside the school office. The school services team have first aid training.

SCHOOL HOURS

OOSH from 7am. Teacher supervision from 8.25am SCHOOL DAY begins 8.55am SCHOOL DAY ends 3.15pm

SUPERVISION

Before and After School Care - OOSH Northern Beaches 7am-6pm.

Before School - Staff are on duty in the playground from 8.25am. No supervision before this time.

After School - Parents can collect their children from the undercroft at 3.15pm. No teacher supervision after this time. Gates closed 3.30pm.

Kiss and Ride - Operates from 3.05-3.30pm on Oaks Avenue. Laminated family name car is to be displayed on the windscreen of your car.

Oaks Avenue lights - Teacher supervision is provided for the crossing on Oaks Avenue. Children are expected to make their way home promptly.

Compass

This is the school's **main form of communication to parents**.

Each parent is issued with a login and password – this was emailed to you **yesterday.**

Compass and Student Attendance



- <u>Late arrivals and early departures</u> must be **signed** in at the school office do NOT enter these into
 Compass
- <u>FULL DAY absence</u> from school <u>parents enter the</u> <u>absence into Compass</u>
- Attendance records are required legal obligation
- Extended absence/travel please email the school office with absentee dates ahead of time. NOTE: For more than 10 days absence at any one time, a form must be signed by the Principal.
