#### 6. Principal's and School Welcome

Introduction and opening for Adrian Pulley (Principal)

Sharing the vision for 2025 – student well-being, teacher support, solidifying great work already in place at St Kevin's, Being a voice to hopes & dreams, and Roadmap to 2030.

Nicholas Dowler (Assistance Principal) - Read through slide confirming School Staff & team

Talks about roles of teacher – teaching, faith partnership, engagement of many components that make up your teacher. Talks about child wellbeing, importance of communication – Compass, get involved, label belongings.

Format change from Meet the Teacher Information Evening in 2024 to GTKMC (Getting to Know My Child) conferences in 2025. Why the change? Historically high turnout in parents for K-2 for Meet the Teacher Information Evening, but very low turnout in 3-6 sessions.

Role of students, resilience, asking for help, communication, learning

#### Amanda Kew (Parent Engagement Officer)

Talked about how the school and families can work together. Drop-in sessions have been successful where parents can meet other parents and discuss ways they can be involved in school life.

#### Nicholas (Assistance Principal)

Talked of essential features of the new curriculum. The importance of learning with understanding, application of learning, progress of children learning with data. Outline of the curriculum expectations and taught hours.

#### Adrian Pulley (Principal)-

Reiterated, the world we live in progress, challenges, children having the ability to learn not just Maths and English, additional subject's children will be learning e.g. religious education history, geography, creative arts,

Adrian also spoke of additional supporting teams – Learner Diversity team. Specialist teachers, administration teams, Vacation care, School sport through CSBB. Wide network that the catholic school offers, not just the school itself.
